THE REAL ALICE IN WONDERLAND

THE real Alice may have never fallen down a rabbit hole — but she did inspire the wacky world of Wonderland!

Alice Liddell met the author of the famed children's book when she was just 4 years old. Her dad was a professor at Oxford University in England, and a teacher pal, Charles Dodgson, befriended the whole Liddell family.

Dodgson was an amateur photographer and snapped photos of Alice and her two sisters while regaling them with fantastic, funny tales.

By the time Alice was 10, Dodgson included her in his stories, say the girl's descendants Cathy and Gabriella Rubin in their new book *The Real Alice In Wonderland*.

On one of the fictional Alice adventures, she fell down a magic rabbit hole and met up with the likes of a Cheshire cat, Mad Hatter and time-urgent white rabbit.

Although this particular story was similar to the others Dodgson had spun, this time Alice asked him to write it down. Two years later, in 1864, he gave her a handwritten manuscript he called *Alice's Adventures Under Ground*.

The next year, Dodgson published the retitled *Alice's Adventures In Wonderland* under the pen name Lewis Carroll. He later produced a sequel, *Through The Looking Glass And What Alice Found There*.

The stories have survived the test of time, evident by the \$800 million box-office bonanza of Tim Burton's 3-D movie version of *Alice In Wonderland*!
